Open to Artists living and working in Indiana & Illinois NOTE: Artists juried into the 2023 Sixth Street ArtsFest will be given first opportunity to enter this year. After April 1, the application will be available on

Applicants must submit digital images, website, or social media examples of work representative of items to be sold at the festival. Work to be shown must be the original work of the artist. No items made from kits, commercial molds, or patterns, copied from work of others or done under the direct supervision of an instructor will be permitted.

Two artists may share a booth space, but both must submit entry materials. Arts Illiana is overseeing the artist village and is waiving any entry fee or booth space charge.

### *Artist Information...*

Most spaces are on paved or concrete surfaces so artists must provide tent-weights for their personal tents for wind protection as stakes will not be allowed.

Artists must provide their own tents, displays, including tables and chairs. Electrical needs must be provided by artists (self-contained battery power only; no gas generators.) *If artist does not own or have access to a tent, please contact Arts Illiana.*

This is a “rain or shine” event.

### *Deadline to enter...*

Entries should be submitted to Arts Illiana by May 1, 2024. Artists will be notified no later than May 8, 2024, of the juried results. Artists who are accepted will receive additional set up information and maps.

**Space is limited and we expect spaces to go quickly!**

## Hospitality for artists...

Volunteer booth sitters will be available to assist artists during brief absences from their booth spaces. Artists will have access to Arts Illiana restrooms and kitchen area during the day. The Cultural District also will distribute bags to artists booths to use for art sales.
